**Directions**

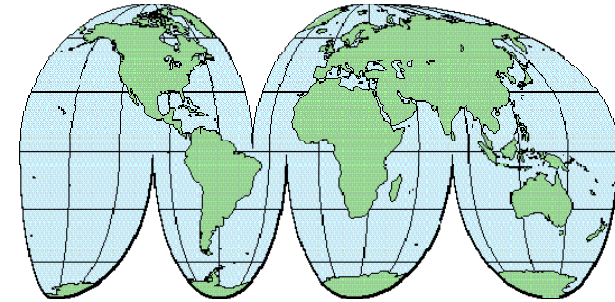
