The School of Education Bachelor of General Studies program is designed for community college graduates who want to further their education and pursue an undergraduate degree utilizing all previous coursework. Students entering from community colleges with an Associate degree in Child Care Development may transfer up to 62 hours of credit. **The Children and Families program is designed for students who are interested in teaching in preschools, Head Start or childcare programs, as well as those interested in working with children and families in agencies. Students must complete at least 58-60 credit hours at UM-Dearborn. Students must work on three areas of upper level courses, including 31-40 hrs in Child Studies (Area I), 15+ hrs in Behavioral Studies (Area II), and 12 + hrs in Elective Area (Area III). A total of 120 credit hrs are necessary to complete the program.**

LOWER LEVEL DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS*:

ENGLISH COMPOSITION (2 courses): Students are required to take English Composition Placement Exam at UM-Dearborn.

ENG 101 and 102 or 116 will be transferred. Com 227 will be required.

SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (2 courses): Psych 201, POLS 105

HUMANITIES (2 courses): COMA 103 and one course selected from the following::
