



Personal Enrichment

The personal enrichment student is enrolled in undergraduate courses at the University of Michigan-Dearborn for the purpose of personal or professional development. Personal enrichment students, who must have already earned a baccalaureate (bachelor's) degree, are not seeking an additional undergraduate degree. They may enroll for a maximum of 15 hours at UM-Dearborn; there is no limit on the number of semesters, but the total number of credit hours for all semesters enrolled may not exceed 15.

Admission Requirements

- Personal Enrichment Application
- \$30 application fee (check or money order) unless previously paid to a University of Michigan campus (Ann Arbor, Dearborn, or Flint)
- Official or unofficial transcript from the institution at which the degree was earned; the transcript must indicate that the degree was awarded. You will also need to bring a copy of your transcript to register for courses, check prerequisites, and obtain permission from academic units as needed.

Policies

- Although the admission deadline is the first day of class, you are encouraged to apply as early as possible.
- A personal enrichment student may enroll for a maximum of 15 undergraduate credit hours as a non-degree student.
- A personal enrichment student is limited to enrolling for nine credit hours (not to exceed three courses) in a single four-month term (four hours per half-term).
