

Recent High School Graduate Guest

Admission under this status is for students who wish to enroll in Summer II courses at the University of Michigan-Dearborn following their graduation from high school but prior to attendance at another college/university in the Fall semester. Admission is granted only for the Summer II semester.

Admission Criteria:

Students must meet the regular standards for freshman admission to UM-Dearborn.

Application Procedures:

Students are encouraged to apply as early as possible. The application will not be processed until all of the following have been completed and received:

- Recent High School Graduate Guest application (no application fee required)
- An official high school transcript including ACT or SAT scores
- Either a copy of the admission letter or a copy of student's fall registration schedule from the college/university he/she will be attending in the fall semester

Placement Exams and Registration:

- If you are planning to register for an English composition, mathematics, or an advanced foreign language class, you must take the appropriate placement exam prior to registration. You may schedule an appointment for placement testing through the Office of Admissions and Orientation, 313-593-5100.
- Registration information will be sent after you have been admitted. You may register online or in person at Enrollment Services.

Transferability of course work:

The college/university to which you are transferring your UM-Dearborn course work will make the decision as to whether any particular course will transfer. You should talk with your academic advisor or the Office of Admissions at that college/university before enrolling for courses at UM-Dearborn to ensure the best possible result. UM-Dearborn can not guarantee the transferability of courses to other institutions.
