<b>\$8,000</b> (\$2,000 renewable per year)	<b>Open</b>	High school seniors admitted with a minimum recalculated <b>GPA of 3.0</b> at the time of admission are eligible. Students must be enrolled in a public high school in school districts with an economic disadvantaged status of 70% or greater as recognized by the State of Michigan (details on <a href="http://www.michigan.gov/cepi">www.michigan.gov/cepi</a> ) from the counties of Lenawee, Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, Washtenaw, or Wayne. Students enrolled in charter schools located within the geographic location of these districts are also included. Must be U.S. citizen or permanent resident, and meet Michigan residency requirements for in-state tuition. Recipients are expected to complete the FAFSA annually (apply online at: <a href="http://www.fafsa.ed.gov">www.fafsa.ed.gov</a> ). Students are still eligible to receive the Chancellor's or Dean's scholarships as well as interview for one of the 12 Full Tuition Opportunity Scholarships listed below.	4 years, 8 semesters, or the completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever occurs first.
or <b>Full Tuition and select fees</b> (Approximately \$36,000 over 4 years, up to in-state full tuition)	<b>12</b>	Among the University of Michigan-Dearborn Opportunity Scholarship recipients, <b>12 students</b> will be selected to receive a renewable <b>Full Tuition and select fees scholarship</b> . All Opportunity Scholarship recipients admitted by January 15 will be invited to interview for the full tuition awards. <i>For guaranteed consideration, apply by December 15.</i>	Renewable based on at least half-time enrollment and GPA requirements.
