FORM A CAMPUS CHAPTER
OF TAU SIGMA,**

a national academic honor society to recognize and promote transfer students. Christopher Tremblay, director of Admissions and Orientation, says membership will provide transfer students with a ready-made campus community for networking, service and professional development.

“Fifty years ago we started as a two-year transfer campus,” says Tremblay. “How appropriate that we are the first in Michigan to offer this opportunity to our current transfer students.”

To be considered, students must have completed at least one semester of full-time study at UM-Dearborn with a 3.5 GPA, and have transferred at least one year of credits from a community college or other academic institution. The first 30 students were inducted in June, along with eight honorary members, including Chancellor Daniel Little and the leaders of seven local community colleges.

“This was a way to thank our community college colleagues for the students that they send us, and for their leadership,” says Tremblay.
