FOR STUDENTS PLANNING TO TRANSFER TO UM-D FALL 2010 AND LATER

The College of Business faculty has approved a new BBA curriculum effective Fall 2009 for incoming freshmen students and Fall 2010 for all transfer students. Some prerequisites and distribution requirements have changed. The changes are reflected on this transfer guide. Transfer students with questions regarding the change may contact Susan Wells at swells@umich.edu.

Admission directly into the BBA Program requires junior standing (55 credits or more) and completion of the specific requirements listed in this guide. Any student deficient in standing and/or the specific requirements can enter the University of Michigan–Dearborn’s College of Business as a Pre-business student. Students do not have to complete all of the distribution requirements prior to transfer.

Students may declare a BBA with a concentration in Accounting; Finance; General Business (with a track in Prelaw); Management; Information Technology Management; Marketing; Supply Chain Management; and Human Resource Management. Internships are available to all BBA students.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS: (courses required prior to admission to the BBA Program)

- 1) Accounting: ACCTG 151 and 152
- 2) Economics: ECON 251 and 252
- 3) English Composition: ENGL 151 and 152, 155, or 254
- 4) Mathematics: MATH 171
- 5) Introduction to Business: BUSAD 151

NOTES: A maximum of 62 credit hours is accepted by the College of Business (grades of C- and below are not accepted). Students are encouraged to complete the mathematics sequence through Calculus I at the community college. **Students may complete the BBA Program requirements by attending part time in the evenings.** It is the student's responsibility to stay in yearly contact with the UM-Dearborn Admissions Office to keep up-to-date with any changes.

A gpa of **2.70** must be maintained in both the overall and specific requirements. Students also must have earned a total of 55 transferable credit hours in order to apply for admission directly into the BBA Program.

"Admission to the College of Business is selective. On an average, students admitted to the College have a cumulative GPA of 3.20. Students with specific and cumulative GPA's above 2.70 have a higher probability of admission".

DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH COMPOSITION: (6 hrs.) from ENGL 151 and 152, 155, or 254. (Students are required to take an English Placement Exam at UM-Dearborn. For those students who do not place at the COMP 105 level, COMP 227 will be required).

ART OR MUSIC HISTORY: (3 hrs.) from ART 280,281,282; MUSIC 265,268.

LETTERS: (3 hrs.) from ENGL 240,251,252,253,255,260,267,268; PHIL 152,253.

BEHAVIORAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES: (15 hrs. with at least one course chosen from each group;

NOTE: ECON 251 + 252 are required for admission to the BBA Program and can be counted as part of the 15 hrs. required):

Group A: ANTH 152,155,165 PSYCH 151,152,153,254; SOC 151,152,251,252.

Group B: ECON 251,252,256; POLSC 151,211,221,252.

HISTORY: (3 hrs.) from HIST 151,152,153,154,155,158,159,160,255,256.

MATHEMATICS: (4 hrs.) from MATH 171.

BIOLOGICAL AND PHYSICAL SCIENCE: (7-8 hrs. with one course containing a lab): ASTRN 151; BIOL 151,152,153,154,157+158,251,252,260,264; CHEM 150,151,152,251,252; ESC 151; PHYSC 151; PHY 151,152,251,252.

CRITICAL THINKING/LOGIC: (3 hrs.) PHIL 151.

INTRODUCTION TO BUSINESS: (3 hrs.) from BUSAD 151.
