LOWER LEVEL DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

ENGLISH COMPOSITION: ENG 101 and 102 (Students are required to take an English Placement Exam at UM-Dearborn. For those students who place below the COMP 105 level, COMP 227 will be required.)

- For all Early Childhood/Elementary majors and minors it is suggested that the student take ENG 205 as a pre-requisite for UM-Dearborn's ENG 323 (Adv. Creative Writing).

HUMANITIES: ENG 203; HUM 150. ART 113 may be completed for elective credit for specific majors and minors.

SOCIAL STUDIES: HIST 151 or GEOG 133

MATHEMATICS: MATH 105 and 106

SCIENCES: Choose 1 course from 2 of the areas listed below:

- Life Science: BIOL 101
Earth/Planetary Science: GEOG 105 or PHYS 104
Physical Science: CHEM 111 or PHYS 181

PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION: PE 240; PSYCH 209 (prerequisite PSYCH 201) or CCD 116

MAJORS AND MINORS: In addition to the above distribution requirements, students should consider their selection of one major and one minor from those listed below. Courses can be selected from the preferred major(s)/minor(s).

- Note: a. Early Childhood major requires two minors.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

The UM-Dearborn School of Education requires a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75. A GPA of 2.75 is also required in the major(s), in the minor(s), and in the professional sequence (i.e., Education courses).

## MAJORS AND MINORS

### LANGUAGE ARTS:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major – 36 Credits with no more than 21 hours earned at the community college.
- Minor – 24 Credits with no more than 15 hours earned at the community college.

Major or Minor: ENG 101, 102, 203, 205 and 280

For major only select from: ENG 116, 243, 244, 245; GER 101, 102, 201, 202; FR 101, 102, 201, 202; SPAN 101, 102, 201, 202

### MATHEMATICS:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major – 30 Credits with no more than 18 hours earned at the community college.
- Minor – 20 Credits with no more than 13 hours earned at the community college.

Major or Minor: MATH 105, 106, 128 or 129

For major only MATH 145 or 150 and select from: MATH 151, 230, 240 or 252

### SCIENCES:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major – 36 Credits with no more than 21 hours earned at the community college.
- Minor – 24 Credits with no more than 8 hours earned at the community college.

Major or Minor - Choose 1 course from two of the areas listed:

Life Science: BIOL 101

Earth/Planetary Science: GEOG 105 or PHYS 104

Physical Science: CHEM 111 or PHYS 181

Major only - Choose 2 additional courses representing different areas:

Physical Science: CHEM 111, 117; PHYS 181, 182, 211, 212

Earth/Planetary: BIOL 104, GEOG 105, 130; GEOL 133, 134; PHYS 104

Life Science: BIOL 104, 120, 130, BIOL 237+238

### SOCIAL STUDIES:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major – 36 Credits with no more than 18 hours earned at the community college.
- Minor – 24 Credits with no more than 18 hours earned at the community college.

Major or Minor: HIST 151; ECON 201 or 202; GEOG 130 or 133 or 217 or 225 or 236; HIST 141, 152; POL 105

### EARLY CHILDHOOD:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major Only: 36 Credits with no more than 9 hours earned at the community college.

CCD 115, 116 (or PSYCH 209), 170

### ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Minor Only: 20 Credits with no courses earned at the community college.

Prerequisite: Modern foreign language courses may be taken at the community college.

### LEARNING DISABILITIES:

#### *Credits Required:*

- Major Only: 30 Credits with no more than 3 hours earned at the community college.

PSYCH 209 (Prerequisite: PSYCH 201) or CCD 116

**NOTE: University of Michigan – Dearborn will transfer 62 credits from Schoolcraft College.**
