



## *Alumni Legacy Scholarship*

In 1997, the University of Michigan-Dearborn Alumni Society established the Alumni Legacy Scholarship Endowment. The scholarship is appropriately named, as it will perpetuate the legacy of the University of Michigan-Dearborn tradition by providing scholarships to academically talented students with familial or other significant relationships to UM-Dearborn graduates.

Since the 1998/99 academic year, the Alumni Legacy Scholarship Endowment has been able to assist in the funding of 85 UM-Dearborn undergraduate student educations.

### Scholarship criteria...

- ❖ you have a familial relationship to a graduate of UM-Dearborn (i.e. you are a child, sibling, grandchild, spouse, stepchild, niece, nephew or cousin)
- ❖ you have been accepted into a degree program at UM-Dearborn
- ❖ you have demonstrated sustained activity and/or achievements in academic, extracurricular, community and/or leadership activities
- ❖ you are an incoming freshman with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- ❖ you are a continuing student who has completed a minimum of 12 undergraduate credit hours at UM-Dearborn with a cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA
- ❖ you are a new transfer student with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale  
*(as calculated by the Admissions Office - based on transferable courses from all previous schools attended)*

Current awards are given in the maximum amount of \$2,000 per student.
