Criteria: The Distinguished Service Award honors those who apply their expertise to benefit the public good and whose work enhances the quality of campus life and/or the visibility and reputation of UM-Dearborn. Activities should be productive in some significant manner—i.e., improvement of our campus, benefit to the community (local, state, national) beyond UM-D, exemplary service to one’s profession, etc. The activities should not result in significant compensation (for example, consulting or holding a salaried political office), but should be for major volunteer efforts on behalf of the campus, community, and/or one’s profession.

The selection committee will be looking for the cumulative, positive effects of a person’s service; therefore, preference will be given to those candidates who have served significantly over a period of years, rather than those whose accomplishments, though highly visible, are more limited in duration.

Awards: One annual award of \$3,000.

Nominations: Any member of the campus community.

Guidelines: Information should include:
