Today, Chinese activists landed on a remote island just outside of Tokyo. They were protesting because they say they, "wanted to draw to China's claim to own the land." Japan's government summoned China's ambassador to lodge an official protest, saying the seven activists ignored a warning not to trespass. For its part, China protested the arrests and flag-waving demonstrators gathered outside Japanese diplomatic offices in Beijing and Hong Kong. The activists were arrested by Japanese police who flew by helicopter to Votsuri island, part of an uninhabited chain in the East China Sea called the Senkakus in Japan and Diaoyutai in China.
